MINUTES OF REGULAR CALLED MEETING FEBRUARY 6, 2024

Call to Order, Proof of Posting, Proof of Notification

Mayor, Mary Alderman called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and announced a quorum was present with Kenneth Baldwin, Wayne Taylor, Marty Kimbrough, Roger Lynch and Simone Johnson. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance

INFORMAL CITIZEN COMMENTS (open for 5 minutes only) - Theresa Rainey discussed her concerns with the flood lights located at 304 NW 4th street. At night the lights radiate towards the back of her house and driving into this area is hazardous. Ms. Rainey requested if anything could be done and suggested dimmer lights. **Shannon Skilling** extended her appreciation to Kenneth Baldwin for his assistance during calls whether it is day or night he will stay there until she is done. **Guyla McClinton** discussed reinstating the landmark committee and acknowledge the Council, City Manager and City Secretary are doing an exceptional job and appreciated all that has been done.

I. DISCUSSION

- A. Phillis Olson to discuss 5th street deteriorating condition. Mrs. Olson was present and stated she lives at 502 West 5th Street. Mrs. Olson is having issues with neighbor using a portion of her property to get to theirs. She stated in 1967 Mr. Horn built the private road to her address and there shouldn't be any traffic except her and would like to take back that portion of the road.
- B. Brandon Cody Newman was present to discuss the unused alleyway behind his property located at 900 NE 4th Street and requested council to consider issuing a Quit Claim Deed to him for the purpose of expanding his property line by approximately 100x20 feet.
- C. Jerry Pierce was present to discuss food trucks wanting to setup on his property located at 201-207 NE Fourth Street and wanted to know if this would be allowable by the city. He also discussed a new idea for Hubbard called "Slap-Out Tx", might bring in more revenue for Hubbard.
- D. Jordan Alonso was present to discuss unused alleyway off of Wells Avenue and requesting council to consider deeding him a portion of the alleyway for the purpose of expanding his property line.

IV. MONTHLY REPORTS

Jason Patrick presented the monthly activities for the city and police: currently doing road repairs; KSA Water Supply Study reveals a 2nd well and storage tank will be needed for growth and will seek other grants for finishing up projects; no police department report available but had 186 citations and 254 calls of service and extended an appreciation out to those who attend city meetings.

Wheatley Recreation Center monthly activities consisted the following: annual Christmas give-away was a success; November thru December Food Give-Away was provided to 1,143 family members; a lapse in equipment maintenance but corrective measures have been implemented and Food Give-Aways are held on the 3rd Saturday of each month at 9:00 a.m.

Fire Department's monthly activity was 511 calls for service in 2023, 62 calls in January 2024 and now Narcan available in each vehicle.
